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BACKGROUND:

On January 22, 2019, the Commissioners Court, through Court Order #129442, awarded Bid No. 2019-061, Annual Contract for Mosquito Control Pesticides and Products, for Public Health, to the following vendors:

After the award was made, Univar Inc. notified Purchasing that they bid the wrong chemical for item 18. Additionally, Public Health notified Purchasing that alternate chemicals bid by Univar Inc. for items 31 and 34 were unacceptable.

Notice of the County's intent to bid was advertised in local newspapers, as required by State statute, and posted on the Internet, the Arlington Black Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Metropolitan Black Chamber of Commerce, and the Tarrant County Asian American Chamber of Commerce. Five hundred twenty-six (526) vendors were contacted and requested to participate in this bid process. All documents pertaining to this bid were posted on the Tarrant County website and were downloaded by interested bidders. Four (4) bids and one (1) no-bid were received.



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Bids were evaluated by Public Health and Purchasing representatives. Award recommendations are to the low bids meeting specifications.

Univar Inc. did not meet specifications for Section 1, items 1-3, 9-10, 13-16, 31, and 34 because the required chemical ingredients were not equal to those specified and deemed unacceptable. There are no awards for Section I, items 44 and 51 because only no-bids were received. There are no secondary awards for Section I, items 1-3, 9-18, 22-23, 26, 29-30, 33-35, and 45 because no bids meeting specifications were received for these items. There are no secondary awards for Section II, items 1-3 because the bid pricing is too high and for item 7 because only no-bids were received. There are no alternate awards for Section I, items 1-4, 7, 9-23, 25-26, 28-35, 38-43, 45, 47, 50, and 52-53 because no bids were received for these items.

Tie bids were received for Section I, items 36, 37, and 46. The award recommendation was determined in accordance with Commissioners Court Order #60616, Procedure for Awarding Tie Bids.

The term of the contract is twelve (12) months, effective January 22, 2019, with one (1) option for a renewal period of twelve (12) months.

Therefore, it is the joint recommendation of Public Health and Purchasing that the Commissioners Court rescind Court Order #129442 for Bid No. 2019-061, Annual Contract for Mosquito Control Pesticides and Products, and approve award to the vendors listed above at the per unit price and discount from list price.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Expenses for last year were approximately \$61,000.00. Orders are placed on an as-needed basis.
