COMMISSIONERS COURT ACTION REQUESTED:

It is requested that the Commissioners Court award RFP No. 2021-051, Disaster Debris Removal, Reduction, Disposal, and Other Emergency Debris Related Services, to the following vendors at the per contract terms:

Primary Crowder Gulf, LLC

Secondary Aftermath Disaster Recovery, Inc.
Alternate Southern Disaster Recovery, LLC

BACKGROUND:

Notice of the County's intent to bid was advertised in local newspapers, as required by State statute, and posted on the Internet, the Arlington Black Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, the Fort Worth Metropolitan Black Chamber of Commerce, and the Tarrant County Asian American Chamber of Commerce. Two hundred seventh-three (273) vendors were contacted and requested to participate in this proposal process. All documents pertaining to this RFP were posted on the Tarrant County website and were downloaded by interested parties. A pre-proposal conference held on January 8, 2021 was attended by seven (7) vendors as well as representatives from Emergency Management and Purchasing. Twelve (12) proposals were received.

Proposals were evaluated by Emergency Management and Purchasing representatives. Evaluations were based upon the criteria and processes set forth in the RFP. TFR Enterprises, Inc. and Vital Emergency Response Assistance were deemed non-responsive for failure to submit the signed Addendum as required.

The term of the contract is twelve (12) months, effective March 13, 2021, with two (2) options for renewal periods of twelve (12) months each.

Therefore, it is the joint recommendation of Emergency Management and Purchasing that RFP No. 2021-051, Disaster Debris Removal, Reduction, Disposal, and Other Emergency Debris Related Services, be awarded to the vendors listed above at the per contract terms.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There were no expenses for last year. The County's future costs will be determined by the services provided on an as-needed basis.
