


COVID Surge!


- TC approx. 337 K cases, 4027 deaths

Doubling Time (Days)


Doubling Time is the amount of time it takes for the COVID-

19 cases to double in size


Higher number: Virus spread is slower Lower number: Virus spread is faster


What should we do?
